

China nationals top foreign UMS intake this year

KOTA KINABALU: A majority of the 156 international students who enrolled for the 2011/2012 Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) academic session on Wednesday, were from China.

Others came from Turkey, South Korea, Algeria, Indonesia and Brunei. Chinese national Hoh Qiu Yi, 18, said she expected UMS to be both good and affordable. "It's very beautiful here and Malaysians are very friendly, that's why I chose UMS," she said.

"I chose to come particularly to Sabah because I think it is very clean and quiet compared to other parts in Malaysia. I came here with a group of friends who are also students in UMS," said Hoh, who signed up for a Hotel Management degree.

Altogether, the latest intake numbered 4,593. From elsewhere in Malaysia, Rajeswary Ramachandran, 20, from Penang said it was her first time away from home.

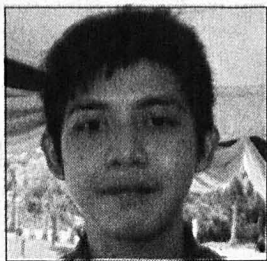

Leong Ming Choong, 21, from Sandakan, will be taking up Civil Engineering said: "I think the level of education here is good. It's a good place to study."



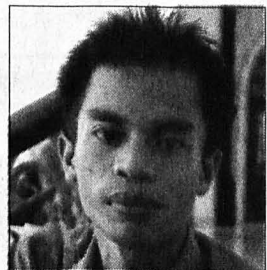
