Siti Hasanah presented an application for teaching Jawi language using augmented reality entitled Learning Jawi Alphabets using Mobile AR Apps.

Dr. Esther took up the challenge of improving English language usage skills among her students by incorporating GVScapes: Mobilising the Scavenger Hunt for English Language Learning into her course curriculum.
