

UMS student among 10 for 'Huawei Seeds for Future'

KOTA KINABALU: A Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) student is among 10 higher education institution students selected for the "Huawei Seeds for the Future" programme being held in Shenzhen, China for two weeks from June 28.

UMS Vice-Chancellor Prof Datuk Dr Kamarudin Mudin said since 2017 to date, five of the university's students had participated in the programme, which is fully sponsored by Huawei.

According to him, the programme is aimed at familiarising participants with the working environment at the telecommunications equipment company, aside from upscaling their skill in technology and employability.

"Three UMS students were selected for the programme in 2017; one, last year; and one this year, Tan Mei June, 21, from the Computing and Informatics Faculty, who passed the screening with nine others by Huawei Technologies (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd," he said, in a statement.

The Huawei Seeds for the Future programme was introduced in Malaysia in 2014.
