

UMS faculty holds academic workshop

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KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) Science and Natural Resources Faculty (FSSA) organised the FSSA Academic Workshop here recently.

FSSA Dean, Professor Dr Jualang Azlan Gansau said that the workshop aims to examine, improve and ensure that the Education Objectives Programme (PEO) and Learning Outcome Programme (PLO) goals are in line for all Bachelor's programs offered at FSSA.

"It is also to refine and empower curriculum design and

delivery, in addition to planning academic staff projections and continuous improvement of programmes offered at FSSA by involving stakeholders.

"At the same time, it is an effort towards ensuring the quality of the programme is always guaranteed and relevant to the current circulation, thus producing quality graduates with high marketability," he said when speaking at the launch of the workshop which was held at a hotel in Kota Kinabalu.

Dr Jualang also said that he hoped the results obtained during

the two-day workshop could achieve the faculty and university management's targets to produce human capital that contributes to society and national development.

"We have also rebranded the study programme at FSSA so that it will be in line with the course structure as outlined by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA)," he said.

A total of 20 faculty academic staff consisting of deputy deans, programme heads, academic quality coordinators and lecturers attended the event.
