

UMS researchers win five medals at IINNCOME

KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) researchers have won two gold, one silver and two bronze medals at the International Innovation Competition on Languages, Education and Societies (IINNCOME) 2022.

The first gold medal was won through an innovation entitled E-Portfolio for Academic Writing

produced by Dr Wirawati Ngui Yi Xe (FPP), Professor Dr Vincent Pang Ah Phook (FPP) and Dr Wendy Hiew (PPIB).

Another gold medal was won by a group of researchers comprising Professor Dr Wardatul Akmam Din (PPPG), Professor Dr Darmesah Gabda (FSSA), Professor Dr Suyansah Swanto (FPP) and Anna Lynn

Abu Bakar (PPIB) with an innovation entitled Exploring the Impact of the Integration of JamTT in an Undergraduate ESL Writing Classroom.

Meanwhile, a silver medal was won through an innovation entitled Virtual Simulation Strategy (VSimS) as an Alternative Assessment Strategy for the Development of

TPACK among ESL Pre-Service Teachers.

It was produced by two FPP lecturers, Dr Noraini Said and Dr Megawati Soekarno.

Both of them also contributed a bronze medal to UMS through an innovation entitled Digitalizing Communication Strategy Training through a Mool for Lifelong Learning

among TESL Trainees.

Meanwhile, another bronze medal was obtained through a study entitled The Development of Covid-19 Inquiry-Based STEM Module (CIBSM) to Promote Fluency among Preschoolers.

It was produced by three FPP lecturers, Dr Noraini, Dr Connie Cassy Ompok and Phreoza Dayzency Missie.

IINNCOME 2022 was organized to foster a culture of innovation among students, language lecturers, and education practitioners at the secondary and tertiary levels, as well as the community and industry.
