

UMS faculty organises activities to enliven Ramadan

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KOTA KINABALU: The Faculty of Science and Natural Resources (FSSA) Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) through the FSSA Staff Association in collaboration with the FSSA Student Association has organized various activities to enliven the month of Ramadan this year.

FSSA Dean, Prof. Dr. Jualang Azlan Gansau said that the main purpose of organizing the programme was to strengthen the friendship among the academic and administrative

staff as well as to celebrate the FSSA students.

"After almost two years of not having on campus learning due to the Covid-19 pandemic, such an event is expected to further strengthen the relationship between staff and students who follow fully physical learning in the Semester 2 Session 2021/2022," he said.

Jualang added that various activities were carried out during the month of Ramadan, including a breaking of fast ceremony which was

attended by about 400 FSSA members by preparing food for breaking the fast in a rewang manner.

Among other programs carried out include the distribution of 2,240 iftar packs to FSSA students through the Kongsi Rezeki program led by Senior Assistant Registrar, Yazmin Suraya Yusof.

According to Yazmin, the distribution program is conducted twice a week during the month of Ramadan.

"A total of RM20,000.00 has

been successfully collected to fund the distribution of iftar packs to students in need. It is hoped that this Kongsi Rezeki program can continue to be implemented in the future," he said.

Yazmin also expressed his appreciation and thanks to all the philanthropists consisting of FSSA members and the community outside UMS who have been willing to contribute and together realize and make this Kongsi Rezeki program a success.
