UMS wins 10 medals in Seoul International Invention Fair

KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) won two gold medals, four silver medals and four bronze medals during the recent Seoul International Invention Fair (SIIF) 2021.

The first gold was won by the research team led by Prof Madya Ts Dr Edmund Ng Giap Wen, after they presented their invention dubbed as the DeColourAR: A Multi-Markes Interactive Augmented Reality Children Colouring Book.

Prof Ir Dr Abdul Karim Mirasa's team won the second gold with their invention called Innovative Production Method of Interlocking Brick System for Green Building Construction.

Meanwhile, UMS' Eco-Solar Dryer, Trichogreen: Valorizing Wastes; Strategies for Soluble Protein Production in E.Coli using Psychrophilic Co-Chaperane Expression System; and Learning Jawi through Multi-Marker AR and Gamification inventions won the silver medal.

The M-Salah Robot Module; UMS Eco-Solar House; GVScapes: Transforming the English Grammar and Vocabulary Learning Landscape, and Hybrid Polymer Film for Monitoring Fish Products invention contributed took home the bronze medal.

The hybrid competition was held in Seoul, South Korea for four days. All of UMS' inventions were presented online.

The competition received 456 inventions from 24 countries including China, the US, Russia, Taiwan, Indonesia, Thailand, Iran, Saudi Arabia, Myanmar, and Singapore.
