

Having an MoU with one of the well known academic institute in South Korea, Gwangju Institute of Scence and Technology, UMS particularly SST has carried out a lot of academic collaboration between UMS and GIST. The recent collaboration was the UMS-GIST Postgraduate Symposium and Internship Programme. The purpose of this programme was to allow knowledge sharing between UMS and GIST postgraduate students as well as exposing Korean students to life as students in UMS. Prof. Kyoung Woong Kim, from the Faculty of Environmental Science and Engineering, Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology, Korea (GIST) head the Korean delegation of 4 Korean students.
