



WORKSHOP ON CONSTRUCTION OF ASSESSMENT TOOLS 1-ATTITUDE & BEHAVIOUR

28th March 2009, a workshop on Construction of Assessment Tools, Attitude and Behaviour was organized at the Hyatt Hotel, Kota Kinabalu. This event was officiated by the Dean of School of Medicine, Prof Dr Osman Ali. The workshop was organized by Prof Dr Peter Barling and attended by 10 lecturers including AP Dr Zainal Arifin Mustapha (Deputy Dean of Academic and Student Affairs). There were 8 student representatives from Year 1 and 2 invited as participants. The objective of this workshop was to develop an alternative means of assessing Attitude and Behaviour, A&B in the first two years of the Doctor of Medicine Programme. Throughout this workshop, it was agreed that evaluation of A&B should be done by both student and mentor/lecturer (60% student, 40% mentor). Assessment will be done once at the end of module assessment. The attributes to be assessed were also decided during the workshop and scoring method has been decided as the most appropriate methods of assessment.
