

SSMP Wins 2 Silver Medals at Seoul International Invention Fair (SIFF) 2013

School of Food Science and Nutrition (SSMP) once again recorded a glorious success at the international level when two researchers from SSMP won two silver medals at the prestigious innovation competition, Seoul International Invention Fair (SIIF) 2013 held at Seoul Convention & Exhibition Center (COEX) from November 29th to December 2nd.

The fair, organised by the Korea

Invention Promotion Association (Kipa), is regarded as one of the largest invention fairs in the world. This year, more than 700 inventions and innovations from 31 different countries including Germany, Russia and Taiwan were showcased.



The first silver medal was won by Associate Professor Dr Chye Fook Yee and his co-researchers for their inventions on 'An Innovation Method for Dehydrated Fruit with Probiotics'. The second silver medal was won by Dr Hasmadi Mamat and co-researchers for their project on "Application of Mango Peel Powder in the Production of Noodles".

In total, the UMS team of researchers showcased 13 inventions and was awarded two Gold, 5 Silver and 4 Bronze medals.
