

A public lecture by the distinguished Japanese scholar specializing in Politics and Security in the Asia pacific Region Professor Yoshihide Soeya Yoshihide from Keio University, Japan was held at the SBE Main Meeting Room on 31st August 2008. He is a writer of several books and among them are United Nations Peacekeeping Operation: A Guide to Japanese Policies, Japanese Diplomacy and China 1945 - 1972 and many others.
