

# ACCOUNTING CENTRE 1st CHARITY RUN 2008

On the morning of 1st March 2008, 133 participants took part in a charity run organized by the Accounting Centre in support of the Sabah Society of the Deaf. The run was officiated by Prof. Dr. Amran Ahmed, Deputy Vice Chancellor (Students Affairs and Alumni). In his speech, the Deputy Vice Chancellor proposed that a bigger charity run be held in the coming academic years to benefit more charitable institutions. Also present at the run were Assoc. Prof. Dr. Noorhayati Mansor, the Director of Accounting Centre, Encik Jainurin Justine, Head of Accounting Program and Ms. Chin, a representative from the Sabah Society of the Deaf.

Eight categories of competition were included in the run, namely



Men and Women Veteran (above 40 years old), Men and Women Open (19-39 years old), Youth Boys and Girls (13-18 years old) and Children Boys and Girls (below 13 years). Competitors included members of the general public, school children and UMS students. Winners received cash prizes, hamper and certificates, which were given away by Prof. Dr. Amran Ahmed and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Noorhayati Mansor. A special presentation was also made by the pre-school children from the Sabah Society of the Deaf. The program was planned and implemented by an organizing committee, comprising accounting students, led by Sdra. William Aloysius Junior, a final year student.
