

UMS ACCOUNTING GRADUATES GET FULL EXEMPTIONS FOR PROFESSIONAL EXAM

UMS's Accounting graduates recently get a windfall news from ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants), an international professional accounting body. From now on, graduates from UMS with the Bachelor of Accountancy (Hons) Degree In Accounting will obtain full exemption to sit for the ACCA examination, which leads to a professional accounting qualification. The qualification will allow the holder to serve the industry internationally. Accounting Centre Director, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Noorhayati Mansor, said that the recognition by ACCA has given a high value to the accounting degree offered by the university. The exemption by ACCA means that students may sit for only five out of the total 14 papers in the ACCA examination. The UMS accounting degree is one of the few degrees in Malaysia that have obtained full exemption from ACCA. In 2006, MIA (Malaysia Institute Accounting) has recognized the UMS accounting degree for membership in the institute.
