THURSDAY, 26 JUNE – Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) received a courtesy call from the Assemblyman of Padang Tengku, Kuala Lipis, Pahang, Dato’ Mustapa bin Long and his entourage.

His arrival was warmly welcomed by a member of the Board of Directors UMS, Datuk AG Buhtamam Ag Mahmum accompanied by the Head of Chancellery Department, No’man Datuk Ahmad at the Lobby of the Chancellery Building.
