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THURSDAY, 9 APRIL – The Malaysian Education Development Plan 2015-2025 (Higher Education) (PPPM-PT) is expected to become one of the country's transformation to compete internationally.

Prime Minister Dato' Seri Najib Tun Razak said the plan, which outlined ten shifts was able to create human capital that was categorised as 3B that are talent (bakat), global (bertaraf global) and based on positive value (berteraskan nilai positif).

According to him PPPM-PT focussed on generating talented students that were important for a country to maintain its success.
