MALAYSIAN PRIVATE ENTITIES REPORTING STANDARDS (MPERS)

"MPERS: Are You Ready To Be Audited"

Malaysia Private Entities Reporting Standard (MPERS) implementation in Malaysia will take effect beginning on or after 1st January 2016, with early application permitted. Publics and privates sector are thereafter mandated to apply the MPERS for their financial statements ending 31st December 2016.

As the new MPERS includes fair value and present value accounting to selected accounting transactions, entities with these transactions will have to understand the new concepts to ensure proper compliance.
