UMS Labuan students to promote cooperative's products to people

LABUAN: Universiti Malaysia Sabah, Labuan International Campus (UMS-KAL) will collaborate with Koperasi Rakyat Labuan Berhad (KORAL) to promote the latter's products to the people here.
