THURSDAY, 14 JANUARY – The Universiti Malaysia Sabah – National Welfare Foundation Haemodialysis Centre, located at Plaza Kingfisher, Kota Kinabalu is expected to be operational in February.

This was confirmed by the Vice-Chancellor of UMS, Professor Datuk Dr. Mohd Harun Abdullah at the signing of the Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with the National Welfare Foundation (YKN) at the Chancellory Building here, today.

According to Datuk Harun, a total of 10 haemodialysis machines have been donated by

YKN to provide welfare assistance to patients in need of treatment.
