

# UMS FC thrash UiTM 14-0

**KOTA KINABALU:** Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) FC concluded their FAM-Felda National Futsal League Women's Group B fixtures with a 14-0 hammering of Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) yesterday.

The victory achieved at the Triways Sports Complex in Shah Alam ensured UMS FC, who have booked their Grand Finals place in the previous rounds, finished second in Group B behind Selangor MPSJ.

Chief coach Mohd Asyraf Fong Abdullah hailed the team's commitment and efforts in their history-making preliminary rounds campaign, which further enhanced their reputation as one of the hot favourites in the Grand Finals.

"Our 14-0 win over UiTM just now was the biggest victory margin this season. In all, we finished the preliminary rounds with 60 goals and conceded only six.

"It was achieved with commitment and determination from the players, although we still ended second in the group to winners MPSJ by virtue of the win against Police early yesterday.

"However, the most important thing is to get into the Grand Finals and we have achieved it," said Asyraf yesterday.

In the Grand Finals, the top two teams in Group B MPSJ and UMS FC have been pooled with Group A third and fourth place teams Felda United and Sabah respectively.

"The Grand Finals will take place at Triways Sports Complex from March 8-11. We will try our best," he said.

For the record, UMS FC were the only representative from Sabah to advance into the Grand Finals of the last edition of the national Futsal League.

Meanwhile, the Sabah women team lost 0-2 in their last Group A fixtures yesterday but it was of little importance as they had already secured their place in the Grand Finals.
