

UMS Launch Help to the Flood Victims

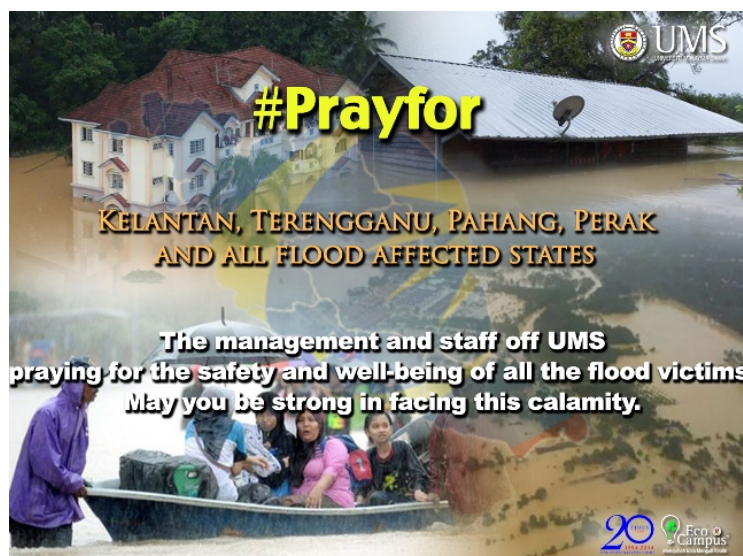
