FRIDAY, 29 AUGUST – Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) today signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (JAIST).

UMS was represented by its Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Datuk Dr. Mohd. Harun Abdullah who signed the agreement at a ceremony held at the Executive Board Room, Chancellery Building.

On behalf of JAIST, its previous agreement was signed by its President, Dr. Tetsuo Asano in Japan.

Advisor to the President of JAIST, Prof. Dr. Shungo Kawamishi was present representing the President of JAIST at the UMS-JAIST MoU and welcomed the upcoming cooperation that would benefit both institutions of higher learning in academia and research.
