THURSDAY, 20th NOVEMBER – Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) grabs two gold and silver medals in the Invention, Innovation and Design on e-Learning (IIDEL) competition held at Shah Alam Convention Centre (SACC) recently.

The first gold medal was contributed by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Lee Kean Wah from Faculty of Psychology and Education with his innovation project, ‘Creating a Personalized Learning (PLE) to Develop University Students Writing Process’, and another gold medal was contributed by Yoon Sook Jhee with the title ‘Kopivosian! Developing Localised Learning Objects for Language Learning’.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Lee Kean Wah also contributed another silver medal through another innovation project, ‘Digital Materials Development for English Language Teaching (DMD4ELT)’. The second silver was from Assoc. Prof. Dr. Tan Choon Keong with his project ‘Measuring Student

Teachers Creativity via Morphological Analysis Method’.

The competition was one of the few programmes in the National University Carnival on e-Learning 2014 (NUCEL2014). This first time event was a platform to promote e-learning applications and practise the blended learning methods to Malaysians.

NUCEL2014, was organized by the Council of Heads of e-Learning Coordinator for Malaysia Public Higher Education Institutions (MEIPTA), Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) and the Ministry of Education Malaysia (MOE), received a total of 194 participations from both public and private institutions of higher education (IHE).-
