THURSDAY, 23 OCTOBER – Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS), Public Works Department (JKR) and Forever Sabah X-Team signed a Letter of Intent (LoI) to collaborate in producing a sewage plant in Sabah.

The event was held at UMS Foundation witnessed by staff and related agencies from the three organisations.

UMS was represented by the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering (FKJ), Prof. Dr. Ir. Rosalam Sarbatly, while JKR was represented by its director, Datuk Ir. John Anthony.
