TYT re-appointed as UMS Chancellor

KOTA KINABALU: Head of State Tun Ahmadshah Abdullah has been re-appointed by the Yang DiPertuan Agong as the Chancellor of University Malaysia Sabah (UMS) for two years effective January 1 this year.

The appointment was disclosed by UMS Vice-Chancellor Professor Datuk Dr Mohd Noh Daliman during a courtesy call on the Governor at the Istana Negeri here yesterday.

Mohd Noh was accompanied by other academic members of the University, including Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Educationand Innovation Division) Professor Dr Kamaruzaman Haji Ampon, Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Alumniand Student Affairs Division) Professor Dr Amran Ahmed, Deputy Vice-Chancellor Internationalization and Academic Division) Professor Dr Haji Sanudin Haji Tahir.

The courtesy call was to present the

instrument of appointment to Ahmadshah as the UMS Chancellor for two years. Ahmadshah was first appointed as the University's Chancellor from January 1, 2005 to December 31, last year.

Meanwhile, Ahmadshah also received a farewell courtesy call from outgoing Agro Bank Sabah Manager Noor Azman Ahmad and his wife Suhaya Haji Mohamad. Also present was senior bank officer Nafazila Mad Sahar.

During the meeting, Noor Azman informed the Governor about the rebranding of Bank Pertanian to Agro Bank effective April 1 this year, adding that the move has turned the bank into a fully Government-owned institution.
