


Abdullah to launch UMS-hosted OIC meet



KOTA KINABALU: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi is expected to launch the three-day OIC Human Capital Management Conference 2006 here to be hosted by Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) beginning Nov 22.

UMS, in a statement on Thursday, said that the conference is co-organised by Malaysia OIC Trade Chamber and Malaysia Institute of Human Resource Management with the support of the State Government and the Sabah Tourism Board.

Abdullah is expected to launch and present a keynote address on Nov 23.

Speakers will be from corporate leaders and senior human resources practitioners from various leading organisations and top government policy.

The secretariat received about 200 participants from OIC member countries as well as local participants, academicians, administrators, students and professionals who are interested to boost their knowledge in the human capital management.
