

Free music concert at UMS

KOTA KINABALU: The Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) School of Art Studies will be holding a music concert this evening as part of its two-day Chamber Music seminar and workshop program.

Dean of the School of Art Studies, Prof. Jamal Abd. Hamid, who opened the seminar and workshop at UMS's Ahmad Nifsu theatre yesterday, said the concert would be held this evening at the main lecture hall.

The hall can accommodate more than 1,000 people and the public, including classical music lovers, are encouraged to attend the free

concert by a 40-member orchestra, he said.

Referring to the seminar, Jamal said it included lecture and workshop sessions by international music scholars, namely Joseph Aronoff (violin), Veronoka Thoene (viola), Halina Ostojaska-Rubczak (cello) Prof Hanafie Mohd Imam (double bass), Joost Flach (woodwind) Akiko Nakamura (piano) and Mustafa Fuzer Nawi (conductor).
