



Planning for second course

THE encouraging response to the inaugural course has prompted the organisers to start planning for the second course to be held next semester in June.

Chairman of the UMS Mosque Education and Culture Committee, Prof Madya Hj Inon Shahrudin Abdul Rahman, said based on feedback from the questionnaires (filled by participants), there is a demand for a course of this nature from university students who have also expressed their preference for a longer period to allow more discussion.
