

Sabah's frog museum

KOTA KINABALU: To know more about frogs endemic to Borneo, visit Universiti Malaysia Sabah's (UMS) ITBC Frog Museum on Dec 14-15.

The museum will be held on the ground floor of UMS' Institute for Tropical Biology and Conservation building from 8.30am to 4pm on both days.

The public will learn many lesser-known facts about frogs through activities like the frog drawing contest, exhibitions, as well as audio-visual presentations.

Those with writing talent can also take part in the 'Continue the Story' activity by continuing an unfinished story about a frog.

The launching of the frog museum also precedes the 'International Conference on Bornean Herpetology 2003' to be held at the ITBC Dec 16-17.
