National conference on religion and society



KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) Centre for the Promotion of Knowledge and Language Learning (CPKLL) will organise a national conference on religion and society on October 31 and November 1.

Head of the Publicity Committee, associate professor Dr Jason Lim said UMS was inviting individuals and teams from the private and public sectors who are interested in presenting papers or participating in discussion at the conference.

and religion, media and religion, education and religion, and literature and religion," said Dr Lim in a statement yesterday.

He also said the deadline for the submission of abstracts is July 30 and UMS would notify presenters about the acceptance of their proposed presentations on August 12. Presenters are expected to submit their full papers by September 30 and their abstracts, full papers and presentations may be prepared and delivered in Bahasa Malaysia or English.

"This conference will be an exciting and inspiring event and the organiser welcomes paper submissions, presentations and participation from universities, religious organisations, nongovernmental organisations as well as other public and private institutions," he

added.
