Sophomore student is new head of student representative council

LABUAN: Universiti Malaysia Sabah, Labuan International Campus (UMS-KAL) sophomore student Md Najib Rubin was chosen as new head of the campus student representative council (SRC) yesterday.

He won the post through an election at the campus's Theatrette Hall where the students voted through e-vote, conducted by the UMS-KAL student affairs and instrumentation and computer service departments.

Meanwhile, Labuan International Finance and Business School (LIFBS) final year student Al Mughni Shah Jabran Aida Ros was appointed as the council treasurer.

Another LIFBS final year student, Keliana Jaflan, was made student service exco, while the school's sophomore student, Mohd Aznil Ashikin Suhaili, holds the training and leadership exco position.

The Labuan Informatics Science School seats are held by the school's sophomore students Lim Yao Li, Yong Yoong Shin and Muhammad Mateen Sabri.

Some 1,751 students voted during the SRC election.

Meanwhile, UMS-KAL director Associate Professor Dr Ismail Ali in announcing the result, expressed his hope that the cooperation between the new SRC line-up would be enhanced for the sake of the 2,000 students studying at the campus.

He said the SRC could hold their discussions with the campus management to resolve the problems faced by the students.

Also present was UMS-KAL deputy registrar Zamri Mohamad Tuah.
