And pact also with Hamburg U

KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) and University of Hamburg, Germany signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on Nov 2 to further strengthen the ties between the two universities, an extension of a previous memorandum signed in 2008.

UMS Vice Chancellor Prof. Datuk Dr Mohd Harun Abdullah said the scope of the MoU is focused on exchanges of academicians, researchers and students, both undergraduate and graduate levels.

The MoU also emphasised on collaboration in research and organisation of international conferences.

During the event, UMS was also repre-

sented by its Registrar Datuk Abdullah Mohd Said, while University of Hamburg was represented by the Dean of the Faculty of Mathematics, Informatics and Natural Sciences, Prof. Dr Henrich Graener and Deputy Dean, International Affairs, Prof. Dr Ing Ingenuin Gasser.

Earlier Dr Graener, in his speech, said UMS has demonstrated its ability to supervise one University of Hamburg student until the student graduated in forestry.

"We are also thinking of a new education system where students of University of Hamburg could study for three years in the university and finish the final year at UMS." he added.
