UMS Registrar Noman Datuk Haji Ahmad, who is also the UMS contingent chief, represented Vice Chancellor Professor Datuk Dr Mohd Harun Abdullah at the prize presentation.

Noman also handed over the Games Flag to Universiti Tanjung Pura who will host the fifth edition in Pontianak, Kalimantan in 2019.

Past hosts for the Games included UMS in the inaugural edition in 2006 followed by Universiti Brunei Darussalam in 2009 and UNIMAS in 2013.

Also present was UMS Sports Centre director Mohd Asyraaf Fong Abdullah.
