

UMS' first learning centre outside Sabah

KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah Investment Holdings Sdn Bhd (UiNVEST) has signed a memorandum of agreement (MoA) with KLIA Professional & Management College (KLIA College) on setting up a UMS Centre for External Education (UCEE) in Selangor.

Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) will be offering the Master of Business Administration (MBA) and Master of Human Capital Management (MHCM) courses through its first UCEE in Peninsular Malaysia at KLIA College in Sepang beginning September this year.

The MoA is for a period of five years and was signed by UiNVEST General Manager Ramlan Awang Ali and KLIA College's chief executive officer Kamarulzaman Musa.

Ramlan Awang said the MoA provided an opportunity for UCEE to expand UMS' programmes outside Sabah as part of its lifelong learning measures.

"Students from other states can now take up UMS programmes at KLIA College and especially a course like the MHCM which is not offered at other local universities.

"I believe the combined strengths of UMS and KLIA College would lead to greater globalisation of Malaysian higher education," he said at the signing ceremony.

UiNVEST is a subsidiary of UMS.
