UMS win women's third consecutive futsal title

KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah continued its prowess in futsal after beating UNIMAP 5-2 in the women's final at the Public Higher Learning Institutions Staff Games in Negeri Sembilan.

The victory at Universiti Sains Islam Malaysia in Nilai yesterday meant that UMS successfully retained its crown for the third consecutive time after winning it in 2012 in Kelantan four years ago.

And to commemorate the victory, UMS sports centre director Mohd Asyraaf Fong Abdullah personally congratulated the triumphant squad for another successful outing.

"It is another meaningful victory for UMS. The team and players have once again made us proud," he said when contacted, vesterday.

"They trained hard to make sure they could retain their title
