20 attend inaugural Vestibular Masterclass

KOTA KINABALU: Gleneagles Kota Kinabalu (GKK) organised the first North Borneo Vestibular Masterclass in collaboration with Queen Elizabeth Hospital (QEH), University of Malaysia Sabah (UMS), MANSA and Interacoustics on October 1 and 2.

The course was designed for clinicians who are looking to increase their knowledge of vestibular assessment, encompassing functional anatomy, basic physiology,

patient history taking, bedside and laboratory examinations.
