KOTA KINABALU: Ahmady Radi and Cristina Ideris were named as the Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) Sportsman and Sportswoman respectively for 2017/2018.

They received their awards at the Student Affairs and Alumni of Universiti Malaysia Sabah (MA-HEPA) 20th Award Giving Ceremony that was held on Monday to recognise the achievements and excellence of UMS students in the field of leadership, sports or volunteerism.
