UMS set modest medal target

KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) is setting a modest target in the Higher Learning Institution Sports Meet (SUKIPT) to be held in UKM, February 2-10.

The team with 18 athletes and seven officials hope to return with two gold, two silver and two bronze medals in the six events (taekwondo. silat, karate, tenpin bowling, petanque, athletics) that they are competing in.
