"I encourage that tournaments involving the university's staff to be expanded and regularly organised as it is positive in creating as well as strengthening relationships and team spirit in the organisation.


"Physical exercise and recreation should be nurtured among UMS employees in order to produce healthy and vibrant work groups in the future," he emphasised.
