UMS-KAL clinic set to open next month

LABUAN: Universiti Malaysia Sabah, Labuan International Campus (UMS-KAL) director, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ismail Ali, announced yesterday that the clinic at the campus is ready and would commence operation early next month.

The double-storey clinic is located next to the female students' hostel close to the campus staff's residence.

Dr. Ismail said the clinic was set up to provide outpatient and early treatment for students and staff and would be opened on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 6pm to 10pm.

"With the setting up of this clinic, students here can enjoy the same medical service like their peers do at UMS main campus in Kota Kinabalu," he said, adding that the development was timely, as the next student intake would take place in September.

Among the facilities available in the clinic were a medical check-up room, a treatment room, a doctor's room and a meeting room.

UMS vice-chancellor, Prof. Datuk Dr. Mohd. Harun Abdullah officiated at the opening of the clinic recently, where the director of Labuan Health Department, Dr. Zaini Husin was also present.

Dr. Ismail expressed his thanks to the Labuan Health Department for their cooperation and commitment in the realisation of the clinic for the benefit of the campus students and staff.

However, for emergency cases, students and staff would still need to go to the hospital for immediate treatment," he said.

Meanwhile, he hoped that with this clinic, students and staff would no longer have to go to the hospital for outpatient treatment, especially during the evening and night, thus saving their time and money.
