

MUIS, UMS receive business tithe from

KOTA KINABALU: Bank Islam Malaysia Berhad yesterday handed over a total of RM320,000 business tithe to two prominent institutions in the state, during its Aidifitri Open House, held at Le Meridien Hotel here.
