KOTA KINABALU: A total of 240 people took part in the UMS Convo Run which was held recently in conjunction with the Tamu Gadang 2013.

There were four categories in the 7km run in the campus which was organised by the Student Leadership Council in collaboration with Sports Science Management students in Year 2 and Year 3.

The categories were Men's open, Women's open, Men's open school category and Women's open school category.
