## Be competitive, Juhar urges graduates

KOTA KINABALU: Head of State Tun Haji Juhar Haji Mahiruddin reminded graduates that they would have to compete in job markets with thousands of other graduates from public institutions of higher learning and private institutions of higher learning who are equally good.

Tun Juhar, who is also the Chancellor of Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS), said under the 10th Malaysia Plan, the Key Performa ice Index (KPI) for the public institutions of higher learning is to produce future graduates who are capable of facing multiple challenges and tasks and producing high quality work that is greatly required by the nation.

Hamid Ego, who served as the fourth State Secretary of Sabah from 1975 to 1988, also served as the chairman of the UMS Board of Directors from 1995 to 2013.

Tun Juhar also conferred Professor Emeritus on two academicians of the university – Professor Datuk Dr Mohd Noh Dalimin and Professor Dr Sabihah Osman. They were given the honour in recognition of their extraordinary achievement in their respective academic fields.
