

KOTA KINABALU: Various initiatives are planned and ongoing for University Malaysia Sabah (UMS) in pursuit of transformation and Industrial Revolution (IR) 4.0, said UMS Vice Chancellor Prof Datuk Dr D Kamarudin D Mudin.

He said among them are the development of a digital campus and the redesign of undergraduates' curriculum

to meet the needs of IR 4.0.

"The cooperation between academia and the industry such as Huawei is important in helping UMS to realise the IR 4.0 agenda," he said during the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signing between UMS and Huawei in Kuala Lumpur, on Friday.
