UMS produces book on Bundu Tuhan

KOTA KINABALU: The young generation can learn more about the history and culture of the communities in Bundu Tuhan through the 'Bundu Tuhan: Konteks dan Transformasi' book.

The book was produced by a group of academicians from Universiti Malaysia Sabah's (UMS) Centre for Promotion of Knowledge and Language Learning (PPIB).

Kundasang assemblyman Datuk Dr Joachim Gunsalam said the book is special for the people of Bundu Tuhan as it highlighted the history of the village and its strength in terms of management, education, tradition and tourism which were not documented formally previously.
