UMS wins five golds at Johor Expo

BATU PAHAT: Researchers from the Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) excelled in participating in the International Higher Education Institution (Pecipta) Conference and Expo 2019 held at the Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia University (UTHM) campus here, when their design won five gold, five

silver and two bronze medals, recently.

According to a UMS statement, the five gold-plated creations are an invention entitled "RTFaceDeep: A Real Time Multiple Faces Recognition for Video Surveillance Using a Deep Learning Architecture" by Prof. Madya Dr. Rayner Alfred of the Faculty of Computer Sciences and Information Technology (FKI), "DeColourAR: An Augmented Reality Coloring Book for UMS Aquarium and Marine Museum" by Assoc. Prof. Dr Ng Giap Weng is also from FKI, and "UMS EcoSolar Dryer by Assoc. Prof. Dr Jidon Adrian Janaun of the Faculty of Engineering (FKI).

Two more gold medals were obtained by two researchers from the UMS Institute of Biotechnology Research (IPB) namely Assoc. Prof. Dr Md. Shafiquzzaman Siddiquee with his research titled "Trichogreen ". Valorizing Wastes" and Dr Nur Athirah Yusof "Strategies for Soluble Protein Production
