## UMS student among 10 Malaysians selected for Huawei Seeds for the Future 2019

NST 16-7-2019 9 KOTA KINABALU: For three years in a row since 2017, Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) undergraduates have been selected to represent Malaysia for the Huawei Seeds for the Future programme held in China.

For the record, three UMS students in 2017 and one in 2018 were selected for the programme. This year, anoth-

er student, Tan Mei Jun from the Faculty of Computing and Informatics, has joined nine others to represent Malaysia.

The ten representatives from Malaysia for this prestigious programme were selected via a detailed "best of the best" filtering process by Huawei Technologies (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd from among more than 1,000 ap-

plicants from universities throughout Malaysia.

This programme, which started in 2008 (2014 in Malaysia), involves the gathering of students from all over the world in China (Beijing and Shenzhen) for a two-week technological study trip.

The trip was fully sponsored by Huawei, with the primary purpose of develop-


ing local ICT talent, enhancing knowledge transfer, and promoting greater understanding and interest in the telecommunications sector.


