## 200 to attend Borneo Sports

Symposium

KOTA KINABALU: Around 200 participants are expected at the Borneo Sports Symposium here from May 3-5.

The Youth and Sports Ministry, Sabah Sports Board (SSB), Sabah Sports Council (SSC) and Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) are jointly organising the symposium themed "Grassroots to Elite Performances".

The first day (May 3) of Symposium will take place at the Kota Kinabalu Sports Complex in Likas while programmes for May 4-5 will be held at the

Tabung Haji Hotel.

Chairman of SSB, Dr. KH Tan, said it was high time that the symposium should be held in Sabah, which he believed would give a positive impact on grassroots level for the benefit of the state in the future.

According to him, wellestablished speakers would present the various topics prepared for the symposium.

"It is not easy to invite the specialists to come over and that is why we hoped those interested should not miss such a great opportunity," he added.

Among the high profile speakers are Professior John Cronin who specialises in human research with particular focus on the strengthening of the muscles.

The co-director of the Sports Performance Research Institute New Zealand will present a topic on Strength and Conditioning, where he will uncover the physical and physiological aspects of developent in athletes for elite sports performance.

"We are lucky to have him as one of the speakers," said Tan.

Other highlights of the symposium are Grassroots Development to be presented by Hon. Sr William Butch Ramirez, Skill Acquisition (Dr. Pathmanathan K.
