## UMS CSR programme at SK Gusi

RANAU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) through the Institute of Tropical Biology and Conservation (IBTP) and Four-Wheel-Drive Volunteer Club (UMS 4WDVC) will be conducting the 5th Borneo Cross Country: Lipan Bara to SK Gusi, Ulu Sugut Expedition from April 25 to 28.
