Tambadau Juniors vs Armed Forces at UMS . . Stadium today

KOTA KINABALU: Tambadau Juniors will switch their home venue temporarily, from the Likas Stadium to UMS Stadium, when they resume their President's Cup Group A challenge

from a three-week break today.

Kick off time remains the same - 4.15pm.

They will face off against Armed Forces FC in the bottom of the table clash.

The state junior squad are forced to shift out from the usual home den, the Likas Stadium, which will host a Premier League match where their senior side will be taking on Penang in an 8.15pm tie.

The last time Tambadau Juniors played at the UMS Stadium was in their season opener against Pahang where they went

down 1-0.

They also lost their second fixture of the season by going down I-0 to UiTM FC in an away tie before nicking their first win in their last fixture (prior to the break), by defeating Penang 2-0 at the Likas Stadium.

Today, expectations are high the team would extend their winning run, especially when they are playing against a side that has yet to pick up a single point after four matches into the season.

Tambadau Juniors head coach Justin Ganai is expected to parade his best available first-team players in their search for

victory.

The evergreen coach will also use two players from the senior side in Ariusdius Jais and Mohd Syukri Baharun. The duo is certain to start the tie in the attack and midfield respectively.

The stateside will head into today's tie sitting second from

bottom on three points.

However, they have played two matches lesser than most of

the teams in the 10-team Group A.

Table-toppers, Selangor who lead the standings on nine points, are the only team that had played the same number of matches as Tambadau Juniors. – FRANCIS XAVIER
