

# UMS to offer technology course based on AWS Academy module

**LABUAN:** The Faculty of Computing and Informatics (FKI) of Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) is expected to offer a technology course based on the Amazon Web Services (AWS) Academy module this year.

FKI dean Prof Dr Abdullah Gani said nine lecturers of the faculty recently attended an online course organized by AWS as preparation.

He said the lecturers attended the "The Train-of-Trainer (ToT) AWS Technical Essentials and Architecting on AWS", where they were exposed to the latest AWS technology pertaining to security, architecture and cloud storage.

"They will also sit for the AWS professional examination in order to become certified professional trainers in cloud architecture this month," he said in a statement yesterday.

Abdullah said the course aimed to bridge the technological gap between the university and industries in the Fourth Industrial Revolution (IR 4.0), particularly in cloud service.

"All FKI lecturers who pass the professional examination will

become certified AWS trainers to teach courses based on the modules provided by AWS.

"As a start, this course will be open to interested UMS students."

He said students who completed the course would obtain an AWS certificate recognized by the industry, which opened up wider career opportunities for them.

"We may offer the courses to the public in the future," he added.

The AWS technology was utilized by clients in Malaysia to operate core enterprise application, data analysis, live streaming video, build e-commerce platform, launch new businesses, host websites, deliver global social and mobile application, among others.
